

Duty of employer to make provision for first-aid

This document has been created as a template for employers to be used in conjunction with the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981. Please use our guide to provide detail and advise when completing each section. The HSE documents and supporting documents can be found online <u>here</u>.

The Health and Safety Executive states the 'employer' is best placed to understand the exact nature of their workplace. Your first aid provision must be 'adequate and appropriate'. This means that you must provide sufficient first aid equipment (first aid kit), facilities and trained personnel at all times.

The below template can be used to capture key information and help you make decisions on the first aid provisions that you need to meet HSE legislation. We have provided a guide to be used alongside this template to help you understand the implications and considerations of the information collated in the template


